COLD WEATHER SCHOOL POLICY

On cold mornings, we monitor the National Weather Service and our current weather conditions. We will monitor the following scenarios:

- The National Weather Service issues a wind chill **ADVISORY** for wind chills between -10 degrees to -24 degrees and at least a wind of 10 MPH or more.
- The National Weather Service issues a wind chill **WARNING** for wind chills of -25 and below with at least a wind of 10 MPH or more.
- If we have a wind chill **ADVISORY** during morning bus runs, we may go to school on a 1-hour delay but we will be in session.
- If we have a wind chill **WARNING** during morning bus runs, we will cancel school.

We are basically a door to door bus service. Most all (95%) of our students walk from the house to the road (20 seconds) to board our bus. Therefore, the cold does not affect us like other school districts.

Parents, please dress your students appropriately. We urge you to insist that your student wears winter hats, gloves, and heavy coats when we have these extreme conditions.
